Process of Application:

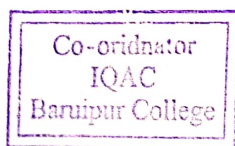
Any Student intending to avail the facility is to provide the following: -


- i. Written plea (duly signed by the applicant)

Applicants need to appear with the originals of the above-mentioned items and submit the photocopies along with the written plea to the G.S. of the Students' Council. The collected applications will be forwarded to the IQAC for scrutiny and assessment, and recommendation will be forwarded to the Principal.
